June 15: Book Summit 2017: Publish Well and Prosper will explore the ways the book business can do just that: be socially aware and thrive economically. Join the Book and Periodical Council and Humber College for a day of stimulating and practical discussion about economic and social responsibility in the book business. June 22: Toronto Lit Up: IFOA and BookThug invite you to the release of *The Unpublished City*, a collection of works by 18 of Toronto's emerging literary talents, as part of the Toronto Lit Up book launch series. (Harbourfront Centre at 7:30pm. Free)
