

RANDY BOYAGODA JOINS THE BOARD OF TORONTO INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF AUTHORS

TORONTO, June 16, 2020 – The **Toronto International Festival of Authors (TIFA)** is pleased to announce the appointment of **Randy Boyagoda** to its board of directors. Boyagoda will serve the board of the directors, chaired by **Charles Baillie**, for a two-year term.

Novelist Randy Boyagoda is a professor of English at the University of Toronto, where he is also Principal of St. Michael's College and holds the Basilian Chair in Christianity, Arts and Letters. His most recent novel, *Original Prin*, was a 2018 *Globe and Mail* Best Book of the Year and a 2019 *New York Times* Editor's Choice. He is Chair of the 2019 ScotiaBank Giller Prize.

Randy Boyagoda is no stranger to the Toronto International Festival of Authors, having appeared on its stage in recent years as both a featured author, and interviewer. Boyagoda also hosts the biweekly podcast series "[Writers Off the Page: 40 Years of TIFA](#)" produced in partnership with the Toronto Public Library, and Library and Archives Canada.

"The Toronto International Festival of Authors has a profound impact on the creative and intellectual life of the city, and likewise on the Canadian publishing community, connecting readers and writers to a flourishing world of storytelling," said **Randy Boyagoda**. "I've experienced it first hand as an author, dating from my debut novel, and am excited to contribute to TIFA's exceptional growth in this new Board role."

"We are delighted to welcome Randy to TIFA's board of directors. Randy brings with him decades of leadership experience and talent as a writer, critic and scholar. Randy's expertise



and energy will strengthen TIFA’s ability to promote writers and serve the book-loving community,” said **Charles Baillie**, TIFA board chair.

“Having recently taken the helm at the Toronto International Festival of Authors, I am excited that this next phase for TIFA will include the addition of Randy to our board. His international reputation precedes him. As an author, scholar and Torontonians, I can think of no better person to help TIFA drive its mission to reflect the city to its residents, its literature to the nation and Canada’s creative ambition to the world,” said **Roland Gulliver**, TIFA Director.
